



The Marina debit card

In the Marina where you are, you need to activate the debit card, by purchasing credit. Outside the Port Office is a coin operated machine to purchase credit for your debit card or during office hours credit can be purchased at reception in the Port Office. If there is credit remaining at the relevant port, the remaining amount will stay on the debit card and can be used in the following years.

With the Marina debit card we provide the following possibility:

To open the gate= FREE

- Keep your card in front of the card reader.
- At first appears €....., your credit on the display.
- Then appears €0.00.
- Pull away your debit card, wait one second and now you can push/pull open the gate.

Electricity

- Place your card before the reader
- The display screen will light up and you will see your credit.
- Press the button where to your plug is.
- You will see that 1 euro of your credit will be debited.
- Remove your card from reader (**For 1 euro will you get 1.3 kWh power, 10 Amp**)
- If you would like to purchase electricity for a longer time this is possible up to 4 x 2 kWh by repeating the process above.
- Remember to press the button for each time!!!!

Shower

- If you wish to shower, insert the card into the card reader.
- You will now get hot water
- You are finished with showering then remove the card from the card reader.
- Your card will be debited at the rate of € 0.25 per minute)

Garbage container

- For the garbage container you also have to use the Marina pay card.
- How to open the Garbage Container
- Press the silver start button!
- The system will startup.
- Wait until the word "SEP" appears.
- Insert the Marina-card in the holder.
- Your credit appears.
- Remove your card from holder
- You can now hear a soft click
- You have 6 seconds to open the valve by hand!!
- Now you can deposit the garbage bag and the valve will close again.

Water

- Water is Free
- On every Jetty is a water tapping point
